

Joint Meeting with Silver Creek Township on April 18,2017 to Discuss Projects on Town Line Roads

OPEN FORUM: Clearwater has interest in 150th St for blacktop and Elder and Mississippi Oaks/162th St for seal coating. They would like a plan on how to handle the projects. Supervisor Langenbacher said they are working on a long term plan for roads and would like to work with Silver Creek on the Township line roads. Silver Creek has plans for Bishop Ave at this time. It will take a few years to get ready to work on 150th Street. 150<sup>th</sup> Street from end of Blacktop at East End to Grover would have an estimated cost of \$500,000 - \$700,000 and will need to be discussed further with that kind of cost. There are a couple of smaller project that could come first. 162th needs to be seal coated, crack filling has already taken place. Supervisor Ludenia said if we cannot do Bishop this year then 162th may be able to be done this year. The approximate cost to seal coat 162th and Eldridge would be \$19,300 with 2/3 of cost being Clearwater and 1/3 Silver Creek. Gowan Ave is also a shared line and Silver Creek is planning to do some inslope repairs this year. Discussed Elder Ave. which needs ditch and inslope work and the corner to be straightened out. A lot of the work can be done in house. Some residents were present with concerns about the safety of Elder when it gets wet, it is very slippery. They have done a petition requesting that the road be blacktopped. Another resident stated that the majority of residents that live on Elder do not want the road blacktopped. A road count will be done again to see how many cars use the road. Both Townships have decisions to make on which roads to work on first. Supervisor Langenbacher has concerns about the Mutual Aid Agreement with Silver Creek and Maple Lake Townships and with sharing manual labor. Clearwater will review the agreement at their next meeting and also discuss the road projects and get back to Silver Creek with their decisions about the road projects.
